House Joint Resolution 4226

1            BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
2 STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3            THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the  
4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state  
5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to  
6 Article VI, section 1 of the Constitution of the state of Washington to  
7 read as follows:

8            Article VI, section 1. All persons of the age of ~~((eighteen))~~  
9 sixteen years or over who are citizens of the United States and who  
10 have lived in the state, county, and precinct thirty days immediately  
11 preceding the election at which they offer to vote, except those  
12 disqualified by Article VI, section 3 of this Constitution, shall be  
13 entitled to vote at all elections.

14            BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause  
15 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four  
16 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal  
17 newspaper in the state.
