BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the 4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state 5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to 6 Article VII, section ... of the Constitution of the state of Washington 7 to read as follows:

8 Article VII, section Notwithstanding any other provision of 9 this Constitution, the legislature may, by appropriate legislation, 10 provide a homestead exemption equal to fifty thousand dollars of 11 valuation from property taxes imposed on real property occupied as a 12 principal residence by the owner of the real property. The legislature 13 may place restrictions and conditions upon the granting of the 14 homestead exemption as the legislature deems proper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal 1 newspaper in the state.
