1            AN ACT Relating to defining allowable fuel blends; and amending RCW  
2 19.112.100.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.112.100 and 2001 c 218 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            Methyl tertiary-butyl ether may not be intentionally added to any  
7 gasoline, motor fuel, or clean fuel produced for sale or use in the  
8 state of Washington after December 31, 2003(~~(, and)~~). In no event may  
9 methyl tertiary-butyl ether be knowingly mixed in gasoline above (~~(six-~~  
10 ~~tenths)~~) fifteen one-hundredths of one percent by volume.
