1 AN ACT Relating to changing the distribution to and allocation of
2 the fire service training account; amending RCW 43.43.944; and creating
3 a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.944 and 2005 c 518 s 929 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (1) The fire service training account is hereby established in the
8 state treasury. The fund shall consist of:

9 (a) All fees received by the Washington state patrol for fire
10 service training;

11 (b) All grants and bequests accepted by the Washington state patrol
12 under RCW 43.43.940; (~~and~~)

13 (c) Twenty percent of all moneys received by the state on fire
14 insurance premiums; and

15 (d) General fund--state moneys appropriated into the account by the
16 legislature.

17 (2) Moneys in the account may be appropriated only for fire service
18 training. (~~During the 2005-2007 fiscal biennium, the legislature may~~
19 ~~appropriate funds from this account for school fire prevention~~

1 ~~activities within the Washington state patrol.))~~ The state patrol may
2 use amounts appropriated from the fire service training account under
3 this section to contract with the Washington state firefighters
4 apprenticeship trust for the operation of the firefighter joint
5 apprenticeship training program. The contract may call for payments on
6 a monthly basis.

7 (3) Any general fund--state moneys appropriated into the account
8 shall be allocated solely to the firefighter joint apprenticeship
9 training program. The Washington state patrol may contract with
10 outside entities for the administration and delivery of the firefighter
11 joint apprenticeship training program.

12 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If specific funding for the purposes of this
13 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
14 June 30, 2007, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
15 void.
