- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.04.007 and 2006 c 252 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 "Veteran" includes every person, who at the time he or she seeks
- 7 the benefits of RCW 46.16.30920, 72.36.030, 41.04.010, 73.04.090,
- 8 73.04.110, 73.08.010, ((73.08.060)) 73.08.070, 73.08.080, or
- 9 43.180.250 has received an honorable discharge or received a discharge
- 10 for medical reasons with an honorable record, where applicable, and who
- 11 has served in at least one of the following capacities:
- 12 (1) As a member in any branch of the armed forces of the United 13 States, including the national guard and armed forces reserves, and has
- 14 fulfilled his or her initial military service obligation;
- 15 (2) As a member of the women's air forces service pilots;
- 16 (3) As a member of the armed forces reserves, national guard, or
- 17 coast guard, and has been called into federal service by a presidential
- 18 select reserve call up for at least one hundred eighty cumulative days;

- 1 (4) As a civil service crewmember with service aboard a U.S. army 2 transport service or U.S. naval transportation service vessel in 3 oceangoing service from December 7, 1941, through December 31, 1946;

 - (6) A United States documented merchant mariner with service aboard an oceangoing vessel operated by the department of defense, or its agents, from both June 25, 1950, through July 27, 1953, in Korean territorial waters and from August 5, 1964, through May 7, 1975, in Vietnam territorial waters, and who received a military commendation.
