1 AN ACT Relating to the developmental disabilities community trust
2 account; and amending RCW 71A.20.170.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.20.170 and 2005 c 353 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) The developmental disabilities community trust account is
7 created in the state treasury. All net proceeds from the use of excess
8 property identified in the 2002 joint legislative audit and review
9 committee capital study or other studies of the division of
10 developmental disabilities residential habilitation centers at Lakeland
11 Village, Yakima Valley school, Francis Haddon Morgan Center, and
12 Rainier school that would not impact current residential habilitation
13 center operations must be deposited into the account. (~~Income~~)

14 (2) Proceeds may come from the lease of the land, conservation
15 easements, sale of timber, or other activities short of sale of the
16 property.

17 (3) "Excess property" includes that portion of the property at
18 Rainier school previously under the cognizance and control of

1 Washington State University for use as a dairy/forage research
2 facility. (~~("Proceeds" include the net receipts from the use of all or~~
3 ~~a portion of the properties.)~~)

4 (4) Only investment income from the principal of the proceeds
5 deposited into the trust account may be spent from the account. For
6 purposes of this section, "investment income" includes lease payments,
7 rent payments, or other periodic payments deposited into the trust
8 account. For purposes of this section, "principal" is the actual
9 excess land from which proceeds are assigned to the trust account.

10 (5) Moneys in the account may be spent only after appropriation.
11 Expenditures from the account shall be used exclusively to provide
12 family support and/or employment/day services to eligible persons with
13 developmental disabilities who can be served by community-based
14 developmental disability services. It is the intent of the legislature
15 that the account should not be used to replace, supplant, or reduce
16 existing appropriations.

17 ~~((2) The department shall report on its efforts and strategies to~~
18 ~~provide income to the developmental disabilities community trust~~
19 ~~account from the excess property identified in subsection (1) of this~~
20 ~~section from the lease of the property, sale of timber, or other~~
