EFFECT: Eliminates 1 additional Learning Improvement Day (cost reduction of \$34.1 million) and redirects this funding to the local effort assistance budget in section 509. This changes the rate at which levy equalization payments to districts are prorated — the striking amendment prorated LEA payments by 84.15 percent and this amendment changes the proration rate to 92.5 percent.
