8 Forest Hazard Reduction (91000005)

10 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following
11 conditions and limitations:

12 (1) The appropriation is provided solely for forest improvement
13 treatments on forest lands of eastern Washington with the five highest
14 priority fire and disease hazards in Stevens, Ferry, Lincoln, Pend
15 Oreille, Okanogan, Spokane, Kittitas, and Yakima counties. Forest
16 treatments on private lands funded by this appropriation require an
17 agreement with the property owner that includes a commitment to
18 maintain the improvements to forest health.

19 (2) By October 1, 2010, the department shall provide the office of
20 financial management and the appropriate committees of the legislature
21 a list of forest health treatments on state, private, and federal
22 lands that are prioritized to improve the health of Washington's
23 working forests, reduce risk to wildlife, sustain or create rural
24 jobs, and support existing or expanded forest products infrastructure.
25 The project list must include the following for each project: (a)
26 Landscape description; (b) acres treated by landowner type; (c) cost
27 to the state; (d) resources leveraged; (e) number of jobs created; and

1 (f) time frames for initiation and completion. The project list must
2 include only those projects that cannot recover costs or are
3 noncommercial for landowners.
