On page 1, after line 16 of the amendment, insert the following:

"In addition, the legislature finds that the governor's 2010 4 supplemental operating budget request contains requests for funds to 5 implement the compensation and fringe benefits provisions of the 6 bargaining agreements negotiated with state employees following the 7 conclusion of the 2009 legislative session. As provided for in 8 41.80.010(3)(b), those requests for funds are hereby rejected as a 9 whole."

On page 7, after line 12 of the amendment, insert the following:

13 "Sec. 4. RCW 1.16.050 and 2007 c 61 s 2 are each amended to read 14 as follows:

(1) The following are legal holidays: Sunday; the first day of

January, commonly called New Year's Day; the third Monday of January, being celebrated as the anniversary of the birth of Martin Luther 18 King, Jr.; the third Monday of February to be known as Presidents' Day and to be celebrated as the anniversary of the births of Abraham 20 Lincoln and George Washington; the last Monday of May, commonly known 21 as Memorial Day; the fourth day of July, being the anniversary of the

2 Declaration of Indonesians: the first Manday in Contember, to be

22 Declaration of Independence; the first Monday in September, to be

23 known as Labor Day; the eleventh day of November, to be known as

24 Veterans' Day; the fourth Thursday in November, to be known as

25 Thanksgiving Day; the day immediately following Thanksgiving Day; and

26 the twenty-fifth day of December, commonly called Christmas Day.

- 1 ((Employees)) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,
- 2 employees of the state and its political subdivisions, except
- 3 employees of school districts and except those nonclassified employees
- 4 of institutions of higher education who hold appointments or are
- 5 employed under contracts to perform services for periods of less than
- 6 twelve consecutive months, shall be entitled to one paid holiday per
- 7 calendar year in addition to those specified in this section. Each
- 8 employee of the state or its political subdivisions may select the day
- 9 on which the employee desires to take the additional holiday provided
- 10 for herein after consultation with the employer pursuant to guidelines
- 11 to be promulgated by rule of the appropriate personnel authority, or
- 12 in the case of local government by ordinance or resolution of the
- 13 legislative authority.
- 14 If any of the above specified state legal holidays are also
- 15 federal legal holidays but observed on different dates, only the state
- 16 legal holidays shall be recognized as a paid legal holiday for
- 17 employees of the state and its political subdivisions except that for
- 18 port districts and the law enforcement and public transit employees of
- 19 municipal corporations, either the federal or the state legal holiday,
- 20 but in no case both, may be recognized as a paid legal holiday for
- 21 employees.
- 22 Whenever any legal holiday, other than Sunday, falls upon a
- 23 Sunday, the following Monday shall be the legal holiday.
- Whenever any legal holiday falls upon a Saturday, the preceding
- 25 Friday shall be the legal holiday.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed to have the effect of
- 27 adding or deleting the number of paid holidays provided for in an
- 28 agreement between employees and employers of political subdivisions of
- 29 the state or as established by ordinance or resolution of the local
- 30 government legislative authority.
- 31 The legislature declares that the thirteenth day of January shall
- 32 be recognized as Korean-American day but shall not be considered a
- 33 legal holiday for any purposes.

- 1 The legislature declares that the twelfth day of October shall be
- 2 recognized as Columbus day but shall not be considered a legal holiday
- 3 for any purposes.
- 4 The legislature declares that the ninth day of April shall be
- 5 recognized as former prisoner of war recognition day but shall not be
- 6 considered a legal holiday for any purposes.
- 7 The legislature declares that the twenty-sixth day of January
- 8 shall be recognized as Washington army and air national guard day but
- 9 shall not be considered a legal holiday for any purposes.
- 10 The legislature declares that the seventh day of August shall be
- 11 recognized as purple heart recipient recognition day but shall not be
- 12 considered a legal holiday for any purposes.
- 13 The legislature declares that the second Sunday in October be
- 14 recognized as Washington state children's day but shall not be
- 15 considered a legal holiday for any purposes.
- 16 The legislature declares that the sixteenth day of April shall be
- 17 recognized as Mother Joseph day and the fourth day of September as
- 18 Marcus Whitman day, but neither shall be considered legal holidays for
- 19 any purpose.
- 20 The legislature declares that the seventh day of December be
- 21 recognized as Pearl Harbor remembrance day but shall not be considered
- 22 a legal holiday for any purpose.
- 23 The legislature declares that the nineteenth day of February be
- 24 recognized as civil liberties day of remembrance but shall not be
- 25 considered a legal holiday for any purpose.
- 26 The legislature declares that the nineteenth day of June be
- 27 recognized as Juneteenth, a day of remembrance for the day the slaves
- 28 learned of their freedom, but shall not be considered a legal holiday
- 29 for any purpose.
- 30 (2) From the effective date of this act until June 30, 2011, no
- 31 employee of a state agency or public institution of higher education
- 32 may receive compensation for the paid personal holiday specified in
- 33 subsection (1) of this section."

Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct any  $_{\rm 2}$  references accordingly, and correct the title.

**EFFECT:** Rejects funding for the compensation and fringe benefit provisions of the collective bargaining agreements negotiated after the 2009 legislative session. No employee of a state agency or institution of higher education shall be compensated for the personal holiday until June 30, 2011.
