

**SSB 5404 - S AMD 163**

1 On page 25, after line 25, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 23. RCW 77.32.010 and 2008 c 329 s 923 are each amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a recreational  
5 license issued by the director is required to hunt for or take wild  
6 animals or wild birds, fish for, take, or harvest fish, shellfish, and  
7 seaweed. A recreational fishing or shellfish license is not required  
8 for carp, smelt, and crawfish, and a hunting license is not required  
9 for bullfrogs.

10 (2) A permit issued by the department is required to park a motor  
11 vehicle upon improved department access facilities.

12 (3) All hunters under the age of fourteen are required to be  
13 accompanied by a Washington-licensed hunter age eighteen or older when  
14 hunting for wild animals or wild birds. The accompanying adult hunter  
15 must stay within a physical range that permits continual unaided visual  
16 and auditory communication with the accompanied hunter. A youth hunter  
17 engaging in falconry is exempt from this subsection. A youth hunter  
18 hunting on land owned by an immediate family member is exempt from this  
19 subsection. For the purposes of this subsection, "immediate family  
20 member" means a parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle, brother, or sister.

21 (4) During the 2007-09 fiscal biennium to enable the implementation  
22 of the pilot project established in section 307, chapter 329, Laws of  
23 2008, a fishing permit issued to a nontribal member by the Colville  
24 Tribes shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
25 section on the waters of Lake Rufus Woods and on the north shore of  
26 Lake Rufus Woods, and a Colville Tribes tribal member identification  
27 card shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
28 section on all waters of Lake Rufus Woods.

1       **Sec. 24.** RCW 77.15.160 and 2000 c 107 s 237 are each amended to  
2 read as follows:

3       A person is guilty of ((an)) a natural resources infraction, which  
4 shall be cited and punished as provided under chapter 7.84 RCW, if the  
5 person:

6       (1) Fails to immediately record a catch of fish or shellfish on a  
7 catch record card required by RCW 77.32.430, or required by rule of the  
8 commission under this title; ((or))

9       (2) Fishes for personal use using barbed hooks in violation of any  
10 rule; ((or))

11       (3) Engages in unaccompanied hunting in violation of the minimum  
12 age requirements established in RCW 77.32.010; or

13       (4) Violates any other rule of the commission or director that is  
14 designated by rule as an infraction."

15       Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any  
16 internal references accordingly.
