

2SSB 6561 - S AMD 112

On page 1, after line 4, insert the following:

1 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the legislature's intent to eventually
2 automatically restrict access to juvenile offender records at age
3 eighteen provided the offender meets certain requirements. The
4 legislature recognizes that because of information technology
5 differences in the computer systems used by the various agencies that
6 would be involved in automatically restricting access to juvenile
7 offender records, this goal cannot be currently accomplished without a
8 significant fiscal impact. Nevertheless, the legislature intends that
9 the agencies involved begin to work together to achieve the goal of
10 automatically restricting juvenile offender records within the near
11 future."

12 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
13 internal references accordingly.

15 On page 7, line 38, after "company." insert "This subsection does
16 not apply to those records maintained or disseminated under chapter
17 36.28A RCW."

18 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Adds an intent section to clarify that, at some point in
the near future, it is the legislature's intent to have access to
juvenile offender records automatically restricted. Clarifies that
the records maintained and distributed by WASPC is not affected by
the provision that prohibits state and local agencies from selling
or disseminating juvenile offender records.
