

SENATE BILL REPORT

SB 5695

As Passed Senate, March 12, 2009

Title: An act relating to the authority of the Washington state patrol to accept donations.

Brief Description: Authorizing the Washington state patrol to accept donations.

Background: The Washington State Patrol (WSP) occasionally receives donations, including donated equipment. Current law permits WSP to accept donations for fire training activities, but does not address whether WSP is authorized to accept other donations.

Summary of Bill: WSP may accept donations of money or property for the purpose of fulfilling its mission.

Appropriation: None.

Fiscal Note: Not requested.

Committee/Commission/Task Force Created: No.

Effective Date: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
