store, and administer medications such as hydrocortisone, fluocinonide,

topical anesthetics, silver sulfadiazine, lidocaine, magnesium sulfate,

zinc oxide, and other similar medications, and may administer such

11 other drugs or medications as prescribed by an authorized health care

practitioner for the practice of occupational therapy. A pharmacist 12

13 who dispenses such drugs to a licensed occupational therapist is not

liable for any adverse reactions caused by any method of use by the 14

15 occupational therapist.
