1 AN ACT Relating to civil remedies for damages to a companion 2 animal; and amending RCW 4.24.320.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 4.24.320 and 2005 c 419 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) Any person who suffers damage to livestock as a result of 7 actions described in RCW 16.52.205 ((or)), any owner of livestock who suffers damage as a result of a willful, unauthorized act described in 8 9 RCW 9A.56.080 or 9A.56.083, or any owner of a companion animal who suffers damage as a result of actions described in RCW 16.52.205 may 10 11 bring an action against the person or persons committing the act in a court of competent jurisdiction for exemplary damages up to three times 12 13 the actual damages sustained, plus attorney's fees.

(2) As used in this section((-)):

15 (a) "Companion animal" means any nonhuman mammal, bird, reptile, 16 fish, or amphibian, that is lawfully owned or possessed and is under 17 the care, custody, or ownership of a person, but does not include any 18 animal raised solely for meat production, production of products from

- 1 the animal, or breeding purposes, nor does it include any wildlife as
- 2 defined by RCW 77.08.010, nor any animal regulated under federal law as
- 3 <u>a research animal.</u>
- 4 (b) "Livestock" means the animals specified in RCW 9A.56.080.
