## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1152

AN ACT Relating to providing notification stickers to drivers with certain disabilities or impairments; adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds and declares that it б is the policy of the state of Washington to encourage the safe use of 7 the roads by all citizens. In furtherance of this policy and in order 8 to reduce problematic encounters and interactions between persons with 9 disabilities and medical and law enforcement personnel, the legislature 10 further finds and declares that the department of licensing shall work with interested parties to develop a notification sticker that 11 interested individuals may place on their vehicle. 12

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 14 to read as follows:

In cooperation with the Washington state patrol, the department shall work with interested parties to design a notification sticker that may be used by an individual who has a disability or impairment that may affect interactions with medical and law enforcement personnel. The sticker must be yellow, bear the international symbol of access, and contain the words "Not a Parking Permit." The department shall design the sticker to be displayed on the upper lefthand corner of the driver's side front windshield of a vehicle or on the vehicle's rear license plate, as determined by the department during the design process. Upon completion, the department shall make the design available to interested parties.
