1 AN ACT Relating to actions by insurance companies against 2 violators; and amending RCW 48.135.070.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.135.070 and 2006 c 284 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) In a criminal prosecution for any crime under Washington law in 7 which the insurance company is a victim, the insurance company is 8 entitled to be considered as a victim in any restitution ordered by the 9 court under RCW 9.94A.753, as part of the criminal penalty imposed 10 against the defendant convicted for such a violation.

11 (2) An insurance company that is a victim of a criminal action 12 under subsection (1) of this section, has a cause of action against the 13 defendant to recover compensatory damages, plus all reasonable 14 investigation and litigation expenses, including reasonable attorneys' 15 fees.
