AN ACT Relating to prohibiting the department of fish and wildlife from paying more than the appraised value for any real estate purchase; and amending RCW 77.12.037.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.12.037 and 2000 c 107 s 4 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) The commission may acquire by gift, easement, purchase, lease, 8 or condemnation lands, buildings, water rights, rights-of-way, or other 9 necessary property, and construct and maintain necessary facilities for 10 purposes consistent with this title. <u>However, under no circumstances</u> 11 <u>may the commission or the department purchase any real estate or</u> 12 <u>interest in real estate for more than the appraised current use value</u> 13 <u>of the real estate or real estate interest.</u>

14 (2) The commission may authorize the director to acquire property 15 under this section, but the power of condemnation may only be exercised 16 by the director when an appropriation has been made by the legislature 17 for the acquisition of a specific property, except to clear title and 18 acquire access rights-of-way. 1 (3) The commission may sell, lease, convey, or grant concessions 2 upon real or personal property under the control of the department.
