AN ACT Relating to prohibiting public service announcements by elected officials during reelection campaigns; adding a new section to chapter 42.52 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 42.23 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 42.52 RCW to read as follows:

No state-elected official may speak or appear in a public service announcement that is broadcast, shown, or distributed in any form whatsoever during the period beginning January 1st and continuing through the general election if that official is a candidate. If the official does not control the broadcast, showing, or distribution of a public service announcement in which he or she speaks or appears, then the official shall contractually limit the use of the public service announcement to be consistent with this section prior to participating in the public service announcement. This section does not apply to public service announcements that are part of the regular duties of the office that only mention or visually display the office or office seal or logo and do not mention or visually display the name of the official in the announcement.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 42.23 RCW to read as follows:

No municipal officer may speak or appear in a public service announcement that is broadcast, shown, or distributed in any form whatsoever during the period beginning January 1st and continuing through the general election if that officer is a candidate. If the officer does not control the broadcast, showing, or distribution of a public service announcement in which he or she speaks or appears, then the officer shall contractually limit the use of the public service announcement to be consistent with this section prior to participating in the public service announcement. This section does not apply to public service announcements that are part of the regular duties of the office that only mention or visually display the office or office seal or logo and do not mention or visually display the name of the officer in the announcement.
