WHEREAS, Immigration reform is required to protect the viability of Washington's agricultural industry and thousands of immigrant farm workers who feed our nation and contribute to Washington's economy; and WHEREAS, There is an urgent need for immigration reform as proposed in the federal Agricultural Job Opportunities, Benefits and Security (AgJOBS) Act that would: Provide temporary legal status for qualifying farm workers, with the possibility of becoming permanent residents of the United States by continuing to work in agriculture and meeting other requirements; and reform the H-2A temporary visa program in a way that makes it useable for employers and protective of United States and foreign workers;
