- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that other states have 5 successfully implemented resident curator programs that preserve, 6 maintain, and restore historic and other significant state-owned properties by allowing private parties to occupy or use the properties 8 for residential purposes, at no cost or reduced rent, in exchange for
- 9 the tenant's maintenance, rehabilitation, or restoration of the
- 10 property.
- 11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.19 RCW 12 to read as follows:
- 13 A state agency with statutory authority to lease state-owned 14 residential properties to private parties may negotiate a lease at a
- 15 rate that is less than fair market value in consideration of the
- 16 lessee's occupancy of the property for noncommercial residential
- 17 purposes and agreement to restore, maintain, rehabilitate, or otherwise
- 18 improve the leased property. Such an agreement must be in writing and

must clearly specify the terms of the agreement and the improvements to 1 2 be made to the property. No improvements to the property may be made without the approval of the leasing agency. If the property is listed, 3 or is eligible to be listed, on the national register of historic 4 places, the Washington heritage register, or a local historic register, 5 6 the agency must consult with the department of archaeology and historic preservation and all work performed on the property must comply with 7 the federal department of interior standards for rehabilitation of 8 9 historic properties.
