
SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5419

1 AN ACT Relating to voluntary donations of vehicle owners at the
2 time of initial or renewal registration; amending RCW 46.16.076; and
3 adding a new section to chapter 43.79 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.16.076 and 2007 c 340 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) The department shall provide an opportunity for owners of
8 vehicles registered under RCW 46.16.0621 and vehicles licensed under
9 RCW 46.16.070 with a declared gross weight of ten thousand pounds or
10 less(~~(7)~~) to make ((a)) the following voluntary donations (~~(of five~~
11 ~~dollars)~~) at the time of initial or renewal registration(~~(. — The~~
12 ~~donation must)~~):

13 (a) Five dollars or more to be deposited in the state parks renewal
14 and stewardship account established in RCW 79A.05.215 to be used for
15 the operation and maintenance of state parks;

16 (b) Five dollars or more to be deposited in the 4-H account
17 established in section 2 of this act to be used for life skills
18 education for young people from ages five through nineteen.

1 (2) This section applies to registrations due or to become due on
2 or after January 1, ((2008)) 2010.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.79 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 (1) The 4-H account is created in the custody of the state
6 treasurer. All receipts from voluntary donations collected under RCW
7 46.16.076 must be deposited in the account. Only the state's
8 designated director of the 4-H program or the director's designee may
9 authorize expenditures from the account. The account is subject to
10 allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is
11 not required for expenditures.

12 (2) Funds in the account must be disbursed for the purposes of
13 providing life skills education for young people from ages five through
14 nineteen.
