- 1 AN ACT Relating to actions by insurance companies against
- 2 violators; and amending RCW 48.135.070.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.135.070 and 2006 c 284 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) In a criminal prosecution for any crime under Washington law in which the insurance company is a victim, the insurance company is entitled to be considered as a victim in any restitution ordered by the court under RCW 9.94A.753, as part of the criminal penalty imposed against the defendant convicted for such a violation.
- 11 (2) Any insurer damaged as a result of a violation of this section
- 12 when there has been a criminal adjudication of guilt, shall have a
- 13 cause of action to recover compensatory damages, plus all reasonable
- 14 investigation and litigation expenses, including attorneys' fees, at
- 15 the trial and appellate courts.

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
