1 AN ACT Relating to limiting the discount of purchases of spirits by
2 licensees; and amending RCW 66.24.440 and 66.08.220.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.24.440 and 2007 c 370 s 20 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Each spirits, beer, and wine restaurant, spirits, beer, and wine
7 private club, hotel, and sports entertainment facility licensee shall
8 be entitled to purchase any spirituous liquor items salable under such
9 license from the board at a discount of not (~~less than fifteen~~) more
10 than ten percent from the retail price fixed by the board, together
11 with all taxes.

12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 66.08.220 and 2007 c 370 s 15 are each amended to read
13 as follows:

14 The board shall set aside in a separate account in the liquor
15 revolving fund an amount equal to ten percent of its gross sales of
16 liquor to spirits, beer, and wine restaurant; spirits, beer, and wine
17 private club; hotel; and sports entertainment facility licensees
18 collected from these licensees pursuant to the provisions of RCW

1 82.08.150, less the (~~fifteen percent~~) discount provided for in RCW
2 66.24.440; and the moneys in said separate account shall be distributed
3 in accordance with the provisions of RCW 66.08.190, 66.08.200 and
4 66.08.210. No election unit in which the sale of liquor under spirits,
5 beer, and wine restaurant; spirits, beer, and wine private club; and
6 sports entertainment facility licenses is unlawful shall be entitled to
7 share in the distribution of moneys from such separate account.
