- AN ACT Relating to the Washington soldiers' home; and amending RCW
- 2 72.36.010.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 72.36.010 and 1959 c 28 s 72.36.010 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) There is established at Orting, Pierce county, an institution 7 which shall be known as the Washington soldiers' home.
- 8 (2) The department is authorized to work with public or private
  9 entities on projects to make the best use of the soldiers' home
  10 property and facilities. These projects may include, but are not
  11 limited to, the renovation and long-term lease of the Garfield barracks
  12 building on the soldiers' home campus.
- (3) All long-term leases of the soldiers' home property shall be subject to the requirements of RCW 43.82.010, except that such leases may run for up to seventy-five years.
- (4) Before the commencement of any project authorized under this section, the joint committee on veterans' and military affairs must approve a final proposal, specifying (a) the lease terms, if applicable, and (b) the development plans.
