- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.56.200 and 2002 c 85 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of robbery in the first degree if:
- 7 (a) In the commission of a robbery or of immediate flight 8 therefrom, he or she:
- 9 (i) Is armed with a deadly weapon; or

- 10 (ii) Displays what appears to be a firearm or other deadly weapon;
 11 or
- 12 (iii) Inflicts bodily injury; ((or))
- 13 (b) He or she commits a robbery within and against a financial institution as defined in RCW 7.88.010 or 35.38.060; or
- 15 <u>(c) He or she commits a robbery against a pharmacy, by taking any</u> 16 substance that may be obtained only from a licensed pharmacist.
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this section, "pharmacy" has the same

- 1 meaning as defined in RCW 18.64.011.
- 2 (3) Robbery in the first degree is a class A felony.
