- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 10.77.165 and 1993 c 31 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) In the event of an escape by a person committed under this chapter from a state ((institution)) facility or the disappearance of
- 8 such a person on conditional release ((to the department of social and
- 9 health services, the superintendent, or in the event of a disappearance
- 10 of such a person on conditional release to the department of
- 11 corrections, the community corrections officer)) or other authorized
- 12 <u>absence</u>, the <u>superintendent</u> shall((, as appropriate,)) notify <u>the</u>
- 13 <u>following persons or entities about information necessary for the</u>
- 14 public safety or to assist in the apprehension of the person:
- 15 <u>(a) State and local law enforcement officers((-,)) located in the</u> 16 <u>city and county where the person escaped;</u>
- 17 (b) The victim of the crime for which the person was convicted or
- 18 <u>the victim's next of kin if the crime was a homicide;</u>
