- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3
- **Sec. 1.** RCW 3.34.140 and 1984 c 258 s 20 are each amended to read 4 5 as follows:
- Any district judge may hold a session in any district in the state, 6 7 at the request of the judge or majority of judges in the district if 8 the visiting judge determines that the state of business in his or her
- district allows the judge to be absent. The county legislative 9 10 authority in which the district court is located shall first approve
- 11 the temporary absence and the judge pro tempore shall not be required
- 12 to serve during the judge's absence. A visiting judge shall be
- entitled to reimbursement for subsistence, lodging, and travel expenses 13
- in accordance with the rates applicable to state officers under RCW 14
- 15 43.03.050 and 43.03.060 as now or hereafter amended while so acting, to
- be paid by the visited district. These expenses shall not be paid to 16
- the visiting judge unless the legislative authority of the county in 17
