AN ACT Relating to the disposition of existing voter-approved indebtedness at the time of annexation of a city, partial city, or town to a fire protection district; adding a new section to chapter 52.04 RCW; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 52.04 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 All property located within the boundaries of a city, partial city as set forth in RCW 52.04.061(2), or town annexing into a fire 9 10 protection district, which property is subject to an excess levy by the 11 city or town for the repayment of voter-approved indebtedness for fire 12 protection related capital improvements incurred prior to the effective date of the annexation is exempt from voter-approved excess property 13 14 taxes levied by the annexing fire protection district for the repayment of indebtedness issued prior to the effective date of the annexation. 15

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

- 1 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 2 immediately.
