1 AN ACT Relating to state certified court reporters; and amending
2 RCW 5.28.010.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 5.28.010 and 1995 c 292 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Every court, judge, clerk of a court, state certified court
7 reporter, or notary public, is authorized to take testimony in any
8 action, suit or proceeding, and such other persons in particular cases
9 as authorized by law. Every such court or officer is authorized to
10 collect fees established under RCW 36.18.020 and 36.18.012 through
11 36.18.018 and to administer oaths and affirmations generally and to
12 every such other person in such particular case as authorized.
