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EFFECT: Removes the requirements that tank vessel owners or operators establish a vessels of opportunity system and replaces the provisions with a required report on the topic by the Department of Ecology, a requirement that the Department of Ecology award planning credit to contingency plan holders utilizing a vessels of opportunity system, and adds clarification that existing vessels of opportunity systems may continue to be improved and tested.

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
