5 (1) "Coal tar" means a material that contains coal tar identified 6 by chemical abstract number 8007-45-2.

7 (2) "Coal tar pavement product" means a material that contains coal
8 tar that is intended for use as a pavement sealant.

9 (3) "Department" means the department of ecology.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. (1) After January 1, 2012, no person may 11 sell at wholesale or retail a coal tar pavement product that is labeled 12 as containing coal tar.

(2) After July 1, 2012, a person may not apply a coal tar pavementproduct on a driveway or parking area.

(3) The department may issue a notice of corrective action to aperson in violation of subsection (1) or (2) of this section.

17 (4) A city or county may adopt an ordinance providing for 18 enforcement of the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this 19 section. A city or county adopting an ordinance has jurisdiction 20 concurrent with the department to enforce this section.

21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a 22 new chapter in Title 70 RCW."
