EFFECT: Requires the HECB, in consultation with the public institutions of higher education, to select a single rising juniors proficiency examination to be administered by all of the institutions. Requires all students pursuing a bachelor's degree and having at least 60, and no more than 90, quarter credits to take the exam. Provides that test results may not prevent a student from taking upper division course work but that failure to take the test at all will prevent registration for upper division course work.
