1 On page 43, at the beginning of line 12, strike all material 2 through "publications" on line 33 and insert the following:

"The higher education coordinating board and the state board for 4 community and technical colleges shall convene a work group, with 5 representatives from higher education institutions, to develop a plan 6 for creating common course numbering for all common lower division 7 courses at all institutions of higher education. The plan shall 8 include, but not be limited to the following: (1) identification of 9 key issues and barriers to implementing common course numbering; (2) 10 cost estimates related to implementation of common course numbering; 11 (3) faculty and staff time required for development and maintenance of 12 common course numbering; (4) a definition common courses; and (5) an 13 implementation timeline. The plan shall be delivered to the higher 14 education committees of the legislature and the governor by December 15 1, 2012"

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EFFECT: Replaces the requirement to establish a common course numbering system with a requirement that the Higher Education Coordinating Board and the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges convene a work group with representatives from higher education institutions to develop a plan that identifies key issues and barriers for implementing common course numbering, cost estimates, faculty and staff time required, a definition of common courses and an implementation timeline.

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
