

**SHB 2190 - H AMD 1304**

1        On page 15, line 2, after "commission" insert ", but the \$3,500,000  
2 must be placed in escrow and not allotted until the review of the  
3 Washington state patrol's narrowbanding project has been completed and  
4 approved"

5        On page 82, after line 1, insert the following:

6        "**Sec. 601.** 2011 c 367 s 601 (uncodified) is amended to read as  
7 follows:

8 **ACQUISITION OF PROPERTIES AND FACILITIES THROUGH FINANCIAL CONTRACTS**

9        (1) The following agencies may enter into financial contracts, paid  
10 from any funds of an agency, appropriated or nonappropriated, for the  
11 purposes indicated and in not more than the principal amounts  
12 indicated, plus financing expenses and required reserves pursuant to  
13 chapter 39.94 RCW. When securing properties under this section,  
14 agencies shall use the most economical financial contract option  
15 available, including long-term leases, lease-purchase agreements,  
16 lease-development with option to purchase agreements, or financial  
17 contracts using certificates of participation. Expenditures made by an  
18 agency for one of the indicated purposes before the issue date of the  
19 authorized financial contract and any certificates of participation  
20 therein are intended to be reimbursed from proceeds of the financial  
21 contract and any certificates of participation therein to the extent  
22 provided in the agency's financing plan approved by the state finance  
23 committee.

24        (2) State agencies may enter into agreements with the department of  
25 general administration and the state treasurer's office to develop  
26 requests to the legislature for the acquisition of properties and  
27 facilities through financial contracts. The agreements may include  
28 charges for services rendered.

1 (a) Department of transportation: Enter into a financing contract  
2 for up to \$10,824,000 plus financing expenses and required reserves  
3 pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW for the acquisition and implementation of  
4 a time, leave, and labor distribution system that is integrated with  
5 the state's accounting and human resource management systems.

6 (b) Department of licensing: Enter into a financing contract for  
7 up to \$7,414,000 plus financing expenses and required reserves pursuant  
8 to chapter 39.94 RCW for the purchase of a prorated and fuel tax system.

9 (c) Washington state patrol: (i) Enter into a financing contract  
10 for up to \$8,241,000 plus financing expenses and required reserves  
11 pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW to purchase and install mobile office  
12 platforms in state patrol and pursuit vehicles.

13 (ii) Enter into a financing contract for up to \$40,100,000 plus  
14 financing expenses and required reserves pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW  
15 to purchase equipment and engineering services to convert to a  
16 narrowband digital system, which is contingent upon the completion of  
17 an independent financial, technical, and compliance review that must  
18 include the review of the utilization of the United States department  
19 of justice's integrated wireless network, which includes a risk  
20 mitigation strategy and plans, age and platform of the communication  
21 equipment's technology, and contractual services and obligations, to be  
22 completed and approved by the office of financial management by July  
23 31, 2012, before any financial contracts using certificates of  
24 participation can be executed. The office of financial management must  
25 request from the federal communications commission an extension of  
26 ninety days for meeting the January 1, 2013, narrowbanding mandate to  
27 allow the time required to perform the review."

28 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct any internal  
29 references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: (1) Requires an independent financial, technical, and  
compliance review that must include the review of the utilization of  
the United States department of justice's integrated wireless network,  
which includes a risk mitigation strategy and plans, age and platform  
of the communication equipment's technology, and contractual services  
and obligations, to be completed and approved by the office of

financial management by July 31, 2012, before any financial contracts using certificates of participation can be executed. The office of financial management must request from the federal communications commission an extension of ninety days for meeting the January 1, 2013, narrowbanding mandate to allow the time required to perform the review.

(2) The \$3.5 million authorized for narrowbanding in section 207(13) must be placed in escrow until the review of the Washington State Patrol narrowbanding project has been reviewed and approved.
