- 16 "period," strike all material through "period" on line 9 and insert
- 17 the following:
- 18 "the position shall be open for filing during the regular filing
- 19 period and a successor shall be qualified at the primary and elected
- 20 ((to that office)) at ((that)) the general election. If a vacancy
- 21 occurs after the first day of the regular filing period but before the
- 22 day of the primary, a successor shall be elected at the general
- 23 election. Except during the last year of the term of office, if such
- 24 a vacancy occurs on or after the ((eleventh Tuesday prior to)) day of
- 25 the primary for that general election,"

EFFECT: (1) Revises the filing procedures for vacant offices by deleting provisions requiring that the vacancy must pertain to an office that leaves an unexpired term for which a successor must be elected at the next general election; and (2) authorizes a special three day filing period in the event a vacancy occurs in an office for which filings have not already been held and which leaves an unexpired term.
