1 On page 2, line 8, after "supervisors" insert ", subject to the 2 restrictions in subsection (4) of this section. 3 (e) Each supervisor appointed or elected under this section must 4 represent an identified area of land that is a specified jurisdiction 5 within the multijurisdictional zone; 6 (f)" 7 8 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any 9 internal references accordingly. 10 On page 3, line 24, after "(4)" insert "A supervisor is eligible 11 12 to vote on policies related to the imposition of rates, charges, 13 taxes, and assessments if the supervisor represents a jurisdiction 14 that: 15 (a) Is subject to the imposition of the rates, charges, taxes, and 16 assessments of the multijurisdiction zone; 17 (b) Agrees to subject itself to the imposition of these rates, 18 charges, taxes, and assessments of the multijurisdiction zone; or 19 (c) Agrees to contribute an amount commensurate to what its 20 obligation would be if these rates, charges, taxes, and assessments 21 were imposed on all lands within its jurisdiction. 22 (5)" 23 24 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any 25 internal references accordingly. 26 EFFECT: Establishes that a supervisor serving on the governing

board of a multijurisdiction zone must represent an identified jurisdiction within the multijurisdiction zone. Provides that only a supervisor who represents a jurisdiction that is subject to the imposition of the rates, charges, taxes, and assessments of the multijurisdiction zone, or who represents a jurisdiction that agrees to contribute a commensurate amount, is eligible to vote on policies related to the imposition of rates, charges, taxes, and assessments by the multijurisdiction zone.
