1 On page 6, after line 7 of the amendment, insert the following:

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- 3 **"Sec. 8.** RCW 47.56.875 and 2010 c 248 s 4 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- A special account to be known as the state route number 520 corridor account is created <u>in the motor vehicle fund</u> in the state 7 treasury.
- 8 (1) Deposits to the account must include:
- 9 (a) All proceeds of bonds issued for the state route number 520 10 bridge replacement and HOV program, including any capitalized
- 11 interest;
- 12 (b) Except as provided in RCW 47.56.870(4)(b)(vii), all of the
- 13 tolls and other revenues received from the operation of the state
- 14 route number 520 corridor as a toll facility, to be deposited at least
- 15 monthly;
- 16 (c) Any interest that may be earned from the deposit or investment
- 17 of those revenues;
- 18 (d) Notwithstanding RCW 47.12.063, proceeds from the sale of any
- 19 surplus real property acquired for the state route number 520 bridge
- 20 replacement and HOV program; and
- 21 (e) All damages, liquidated or otherwise, collected under any
- 22 contract involving the state route number 520 bridge replacement and
- 23 HOV program.
- 24 (2) Subject to the covenants made by the state in the bond
- 25 proceedings authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds for the state
- 26 route number 520 bridge replacement and HOV program and article II,
- 27 section 40 of the state Constitution, toll charges, other revenues,

- $1\ \mbox{and}$ interest received from the operation of the state route number 520
- 2 corridor as a toll facility may be used to:
- 3 (a) Pay any required costs allowed under RCW 47.56.820 and article
- 4 II, section 40 of the state Constitution; and
- 5 (b) Repay amounts to the motor vehicle fund as required.
- 6 (3) When repaying the motor vehicle fund, the state treasurer
- 7 shall transfer funds from the state route number 520 corridor account
- 8 to the motor vehicle fund on or before each debt service date for
- 9 bonds issued for the state route number 520 bridge replacement and HOV
- 10 program in an amount sufficient to repay the motor vehicle fund for
- 11 amounts transferred from that fund to the highway bond retirement fund
- 12 to provide for any bond principal and interest due on that date. The
- 13 state treasurer may establish subaccounts for the purpose of
- 14 segregating toll charges, bond sale proceeds, and other revenues."

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- 16 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
- 17 internal references accordingly. Correct the title.

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EFFECT: Limits the allowable use of toll revenues collected on the state route 520 corridor to uses consistent with the 18th amendment to the state Constitution.

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
