

**SHB 2326** - S AMD TO ENV COMM AMD (S4849.2) **165**

1        On page 5, line 4 of the amendment, after "(7)" insert "On the  
2 effective date of this section, and prior to January 1, 2015, the local  
3 air pollution control authority or the department shall, within  
4 available resources, provide assistance to households using solid fuel  
5 burning devices to reduce the emissions from those devices or change  
6 out to a lower emission device. Prior to the effective date of any  
7 prohibition on the use of uncertified stoves, the department or local  
8 air pollution control authority shall provide public education in the  
9 nonattainment area regarding how households can reduce their emissions  
10 through cleaner burning practices, the importance of respecting burn  
11 bans, and the opportunities for assistance in obtaining a cleaner  
12 device. If the area is designated as a nonattainment area as of  
13 January 1, 2015, or if required by the United States environmental  
14 protection agency, the local air pollution control authority or the  
15 department may prohibit the use of uncertified devices.

17        On page 5, beginning on line 7 of the amendment, after "(b)" strike  
18 all material through "department." on line 10 and insert "Prohibit the  
19 use" or "prohibition" may include requiring disclosure of an  
20 uncertified device, removal, or rendering inoperable, as may be  
21 approved by rule by a local air pollution control authority or the  
22 department. The effective date of such a rule may not be prior to  
23 January 1, 2015."
