On page 5, line 27 of the amendment, after "(7)" insert "On the 1 2 effective date of this section, and prior to January 1, 2015, the local air pollution control authority or the department shall, within 3 available resources, provide assistance to households using solid fuel 4 burning devices to reduce the emissions from those devices or change 5 out to a lower emission device. Prior to the effective date of a б prohibition, as defined in this section, on the use of uncertified 7 stoves, the department or local air pollution control authority shall 8 provide public education in the nonattainment area regarding how 9 households can reduce their emissions through cleaner burning 10 11 practices, the importance of respecting burn bans, and the opportunities for assistance in obtaining a cleaner device. If the 12 area is designated as a nonattainment area as of January 1, 2015, or if 13 required by the United States environmental protection agency, the 14 local air pollution control authority or the department may prohibit 15 the use of uncertified devices. 16

On page 5, beginning on line 30 of the amendment, after "(b)" strike all material through "<u>particulates.</u>" on line 34 and insert "<u>"Prohibit the use" or "prohibition" may include requiring disclosure</u> of an uncertified device, removal, or rendering inoperable, as may be approved by rule by a local air pollution control authority or the department. The effective date of such a rule may not be prior to January 1, 2015."

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
