1           On page 2, line 17, after "2012" insert the following:  
2 "unless the major political parties agree to use only the results of  
3 the presidential primary election for allocation of no less than fifty  
4 percent of their delegates to the national nominating convention. The  
5 major political parties must agree to allocate their delegates in  
6 proportion to the votes each of the parties' candidates receive. The  
7 parties must notify the secretary of state of the parties' decisions  
8 regarding allocation of their delegates by September first of the year  
9 before the year in which the presidential nominee is selected."

EFFECT: The 2012 presidential primary may proceed, but only if the major political parties agree to use the presidential primary to allocate at least 50% of their delegates to the national nominating convention.
