- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.200 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) For the purposes of this section:
- 7 (a) "Credit card" means a card or device existing for the purpose 8 of obtaining money, goods, or services on credit.
- 9 (b) "Customer" means any person who is or may be required to pay 10 for goods or services.
- 11 (c) "Debit card" means a card or device used to obtain money, 12 goods, or services by a transaction that debits a cardholder's account, 13 rather than extending credit.
- (d) "Seller" means any person who provides, offers to provide, or arranges for others to provide goods or services to a customer in
- 16 exchange for consideration.
- 17 (2) When a customer is making a payment on an existing account, a 18 seller may not require as a condition of payment by credit or debit

card that the customer consent to authorizing any future charges against the customer's credit or debit card.

- (3) This section does not prohibit a seller from charging future payments against the customer's credit or debit card if the customer consents.
- (4) This section does not prohibit a seller from requiring that a customer provide credit or debit card information to the seller for future charges at the initiation of an account.
