1 AN ACT Relating to skiing in an area closed to the public; amending 2 RCW 9A.52.080; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.52.080 and 1979 ex.s. c 244 s 13 are each amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of criminal trespass in the second degree if 7 he <u>or she</u> knowingly:

8 <u>(a) Enters or remains unlawfully in or upon premises of another</u> 9 under circumstances not constituting criminal trespass in the first 10 degree<u>; or</u>

(b) Skis in an area or on a ski trail, owned or controlled by a ski area operator, that is closed to the public and that has signs posted indicating the closure.

(2) Criminal trespass in the second degree is a misdemeanor.
