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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 51.14 RCW to read as follows: 6
- 7 (1) When issuing payments of temporary disability benefits as provided in RCW 51.32.090, the self-insurer shall provide notice to the injured worker of the specific purpose of the payment and the time 10 period for which the payment covers.
- 11 (2) The insurer must provide an explanation to the injured worker or beneficiary when the benefit amount or time period covered changes. 12
- 13 (3) Failure of a self-insurer to comply with this section subjects the self-insurer to a penalty under RCW 51.48.080. The director shall 14 15 issue an order determining whether a violation has occurred within 16 thirty days of a request by an injured worker.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 51.14 RCW to read as follows: 18

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Failure of a self-insurer to comply with RCW 51.36.085 subjects the self-insurer to a penalty under RCW 51.48.080. The director shall issue an order determining whether a violation has occurred when requested by an injured worker.

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
