- amending RCW 28B.50.1401 and 28B.45.0201; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the growth in NEW SECTION. 5 demand for technical education by the industry in north King county and 6 south Snohomish county has created the need to expand technical workforce education and training programs. It is the intent of the 8 legislature to create a polytechnic college to meet this need. 9 Therefore the legislature directs Lake Washington Institute 10 Technology to continue to broaden its technical education as a

1 **Sec. 3.** RCW 28B.45.0201 and 1994 c 217 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:

The legislature finds that population growth in north King and 3 4 south Snohomish counties has created a need to expand higher education and workforce training programs for the people living and working in 5 In keeping with the recommendations of the higher 6 education coordinating board, the legislature intends to help address 7 8 those education and training needs through the creation of Cascadia 9 Community College, expansion of educational opportunities at Lake Washington ((Technical College)) Institute of Technology, and support 10 11 of the University of Washington's branch campus at Bothell-Woodinville. 12 It is further the intention of the legislature, in keeping with the 13 higher education coordinating board recommendations, that the Cascadia Community College and the University of Washington branch campus be 14 15 collocated, and that the new community college and the University of Washington's branch campus work in partnership to ensure that properly 16 prepared students from community colleges and other institutions are 17 able to transfer smoothly to the branch campus. 18

The legislature further finds that a governing board for Cascadia Community College needs to be appointed and confirmed as expeditiously as possible. The legislature intends to work cooperatively with the governor to facilitate the appointment and confirmation of trustees for the college.
