1 AN ACT Relating to promoting prostitution; amending RCW 9A.88.070;
2 and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.88.070 and 2007 c 368 s 13 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of promoting prostitution in the first
7 degree if he or she knowingly advances prostitution:

8 (a) By compelling a person by threat or force to engage in
9 prostitution or profits from prostitution which results from such
10 threat or force; or

11 (b) By compelling a person with a mental disability, that renders
12 the person incapable of consent, to engage in prostitution or profits
13 from prostitution.

14 (2) Promoting prostitution in the first degree is a class B felony.
