State of Washington

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 38.16.015 and 1989 c 19 s 30 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- (1) The period of enlistment in the Washington state guard shall be 6 7 set by regulation by the adjutant general((: PROVIDED, That)).
- However, no original enlistment may be consummated unless the term 8
- 9 thereof can be completed before the applicant attains the age of sixty-
- 10 four.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the adjutant 11
- general may extend the service age upon request by an active member of 12
- 13 the Washington state guard if the member proves satisfactory completion
- 14 of physical and mental requirements and the member lives in an area
- 15 where there is a specific military need for the state quard services.
- 16 Extensions under this subsection have a one-year duration and may be
- 17 renewed.
