3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.24.026 and 2010 1st sp.s. c 22 s 3 are each amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (((1))) In addition to the tax imposed upon the sale, use, 7 consumption, handling, possession, or distribution of cigarettes set 8 forth in RCW 82.24.020, there is imposed a tax in an amount equal to 9 three cents per cigarette.

10 ((((2))) <u>Beginning July 1, 2010, the revenue collected under this</u> 11 section must be deposited ((as follows:

12 (a) 14 percent must be deposited)) into the general fund.

13 (((b)-The-remainder-must-be-deposited-into-the-education-legacy
14 trust-account.))

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

- 1 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
