- The legislature finds that population growth in north King and
- 14 south Snohomish counties has created a need to expand higher education
- 15 and workforce training programs for the people living and working in
- 16 those areas. In keeping with the recommendations of the higher
- 17 education coordinating board, the legislature intends to help address
- 18 those education and training needs through the creation of Cascadia

- Community College, expansion of educational opportunities at Lake 1
- 2 Washington ((Technical College)) Institute of Technology, and support
- of the University of Washington's branch campus at Bothell-Woodinville. 3
- It is further the intention of the legislature, in keeping with the 4
- higher education coordinating board recommendations, that the Cascadia 5
