- 2 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 29A.08
- 3 RCW to read as follows:
- 4 (1) A person who is at least sixteen years of age and who meets
- 5 all requirements to vote except age may preregister to vote at the
- 6 department of licensing at the time he or she applies for a driver's
- 7 license or a state identification card.
- 8 (2) The voter's preregistration will be held from entry in the
- 9 statewide voter registration database until such time as the voter
- 10 will be eighteen years of age before the next election.
- 11 (3) A confirmation notice must be sent to the registrant's address
- 12 ninety days prior to the time he or she is eligible to be registered
- 13 as a voter in the statewide voter registration database. The
- 14 confirmation notice must include:
- 15 (a) A declaration that the registrant must sign, under penalty of
- 16 perjury, indicating his or her current legal address. The declaration
- 17 must be returned to the county auditor and the signature on the
- 18 declaration must be verified against the signature on the
- 19 preregistration application. If the signatures do not match, the
- 20 county auditor should provide notice to the registrant of any such
- 21 discrepancy.
- (b) A check box indicating that the registrant is in the military
- 23 and not available to sign the declaration. The parent or guardian of
- 24 the registrant may sign the declaration, under penalty of perjury,
- 25 stating the current legal address of the registrant.

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- 1 (c) Information on how a military voter may obtain, vote, and 2 return a ballot to the county auditor, including applicable web sites 3 for regarding election information and downloading a ballot.
- 4 (4) Upon receiving acceptable verification, the county auditor 5 must register the voter in the statewide voter registration database."

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Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any sinternal references accordingly.

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EFFECT: Requires the county auditor to send a confirmation notice to persons who have preregistered to vote 90 days before they are eligible to be registered as a voter in the statewide voter registration database. Registrants must respond with a signed declaration and the signature on the declaration must match the signature on the preregistration application in order to be included as a voter in the statewide voter registration database. Allows the

signature on the preregistration application in order to be included as a voter in the statewide voter registration database. Allows the parent or guardian of a registrant serving in the military to sign and return the declaration indicating the current legal address of the registrant. Requires that the confirmation notice include information on how a military voter may obtain, vote, and return a ballot to the county auditor, as well as applicable web sites for information and downloading a ballot.

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
