4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.240
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 Beginning July 1, 2015, no manufacturer, wholesaler, or retailer
7 may manufacture, knowingly sell, offer for sale, distribute for
8 sale, or distribute for use in this state children's products
9 containing TDCPP (tris(1,3-dichloro-2-propyl)phosphate), chemical
10 abstracts service number 13674-87-8, as of the effective date of
11 this section, or TCEP (tris(2-chloroethyl) phosphate), chemical
12 abstracts service number 115-96-8, as of the effective date of this
13 section in amounts greater than one hundred parts per million in any
14 product component."

16 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Retains the restrictions on the use of TDCPP and TCEP in children's products or residential upholstered furniture in amounts greater than 100 parts per million in any product component, beginning July 1, 2015. Deletes provisions restricting the use of Chemicals of High Concern for Children, allowing for exemptions from those restrictions upon the completion of an alternatives assessment process, and requiring the submission of certificates of compliance. Allows for the assessment of fines of up to \$5,000 for all violations by manufacturers, rather than \$1,000 for initial violations and \$5,000 for subsequent violations.
